Junior School Charges

Years 7-10 2021

Bossley Park High School values the contributions parents make to the school to support the purchase of learning resources. I would like to inform parents of the purpose and importance of our various charges. **Parental support in the prompt payment of these charges in the past has ensured the very best of education at Bossley Park High School.**

- There is the general contribution, set at \$50.00 per student. This still, remains less than half the figure suggested by the Department of Education. We call this the **Administration** charge. It is used chiefly to supplement government funding and to make possible such purchases as library resources, school environment improvements, learning material and certificates. A professionally printed school diary is provided by the school as part of Administration Charges.
- There is a **Community Support Group** (CSG) levy of \$2.00 per student. The CSG is the school's parent body (commonly referred to as the P&C) which acts in a governance role and does not undertake any fundraising. Parents and interested community members are welcome to attend CSG meetings. These funds are used to fund Parent based initiatives within the school. One example is the payment of the ambulance transport levy. This insurance scheme provides free ambulance transport for students should an accident at school occur.
- An **E-Learning** charge of \$33.00 is charged. The school is highly regarded by Departmental and Industry sources. The E-Learning charge assists the provision of class sets of Chromebooks, laptops and MacBook's as well as smartboards in classrooms and the provision of a technical support officer. This supports the school's emphasis to have state of the art technology and to increase opportunities for student access and skill development. Each student receives a "smart card" with a personalised photograph embossed on it. This card enables students to be identified as needed and includes a \$5.00 allowance for photocopying (on the library printer). The school will provide each student with a subscription to [Education Perfect](#) for Mathematics and [Stile](#) for Science. These are online programs that the students will use at home for revision and for course work.
- The **Sport** charge (listed below) is used to purchase good quality sporting equipment and to subsidise, where necessary, the cost of sports buses. Year 7 students will have a charge \$60 for **Swim School** which is a compulsory school event in term 4 2021 for all students in years 7 & 8.

- There are **Elective** charges set for years 8, 9 & 10 to cover **the cost of materials used by students in those courses**. If these charges are not paid, then the student will be expected to supply the necessary materials himself/herself in order to participate in those particular learning activities and to meet course requirements.
