The Performing Arts Faculty has organised for specialist tutors to come to the school to give singing, guitar, piano and drum lessons. Students will be taught to read music and to be able to play/sing in a variety of styles of music. The lessons will be scheduled during the school day. A time slot is given at the start of each term. It is the student's responsibility to catch up on the work missed during that time. A progress report will be given at the end of each term. It is best to pay for the lessons by the term in advance: Term 1 = 8 weeks, Term 2 = 8 weeks, Term 3 = 8 weeks and Term 4 = 8 weeks.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Students must commit themselves for a minimum of one term by making a block payment to the tutor. The tutors will be booked on a permanent basis each term for the required time. Tutors appreciate payment in advance.
- 2. 24 hours notice must be given to the Head Teacher Ms Lopez or Ms Wais, if you are unable to attend a lesson. Otherwise you will still have to pay for the lesson.
- 3. Ms Lopez, Ms Wais and/or your tutor must be given a week's notice for exams, tests, incursions and excursions otherwise you will still have to pay for the lesson.
